

PRIVACY POLICY

AT STRAMBLY BLAMBY LLC WE ARE COMMITTED TO HIGH ETHICAL STANDARDS RELATING TO THE COLLECTION, USE, AND CONFIDENTIALITY OF THE INFORMATION WE RECEIVE.

This Privacy Policy describes our policies and procedures on the collection, use, and disclosure of your information when using our Service and tells you about your privacy rights and how the law protects you.

Our privacy policy covers all personal information we receive in all possible formats and is based on widely recognized data protection principles.

1. COLLECTION AND USE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

a. Types of Data Collected

i. Personal Data

While using stramblyblamby.com, we may ask you to provide us with certain personal identifying information that can be used to contact or identify you. Personal identifying information may include, but is not limited to:

- Email address
- First name and last name

ii. Choice

Strambly Blamby LLC provides individuals with the opportunity to opt out of the disclosure of their personal information to third parties or its use for purposes materially different from those for which it was originally collected or subsequently authorized. We ensure clear, conspicuous, and readily available mechanisms for individuals to exercise their choice regarding their personal data. Individuals may opt out by using our direct contact form, or contact us using the information provided in this privacy policy to manage your preferences.

b. Usage Data

i. Usage Data

Usage Data is collected automatically when you use the Service. Usage Data may include information such as your device's Internet Protocol address (IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of stramblyblamby.com that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on each page, unique device identifiers, and other diagnostic data.

When you access the Service by or through a mobile device, we may collect certain information automatically, including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device you use, the unique ID of your mobile device, the IP address of your mobile device, your mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser you use, unique device identifiers, and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit stramblyblamby.com or when you access it by or through a mobile device.

ii. Tracking Technologies and Cookies

We use Cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on stramblyblamby.com and store certain information. Tracking technologies used may include beacons, tags, and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze our website. For more information about the tracking technologies we use and your choices regarding cookies, please visit our Cookies Policy.

2. USE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Strambly Blamby LLC may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

- To provide and maintain stramblyblamby.com, including to monitor the usage of our Service.
- **To manage your account:** To manage your registration as a user of the Service. The Personal Data you provide can give you access to different functionalities of the Service that are available to you as a registered user.
- **To facilitate the performance of a contract:** To facilitate the development, compliance, and undertaking of the purchase contract for the products, items, or services you have purchased or of any other contract with us through the Service.
- **To contact you:** To contact you by email, telephone calls, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication, such as a mobile application's push notifications regarding updates or informative communications related to the functionalities, products, or contracted services, including security updates, when necessary or reasonable for their implementation.
- **To provide you with news and general information** about other goods, services, and events which we offer that are similar to those that you have already purchased or enquired about unless you have opted not to receive such information.
- **To manage your requests:** To attend and manage your requests to us.
- **For business transfers:** We may use your information to evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceedings, in which Personal Data held by us about our Service users is among the assets transferred.
- **For other purposes:** We may use your information for other purposes, such as data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns, and to evaluate and improve our Service, products, services, marketing, and your experience.

We may share your personal information in the following situations:

- **With service providers:** We may share your personal information with service providers to monitor and analyze the use of our Service, to contact you.
- **For business transfers:** We may share or transfer your personal information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company.
- **With affiliates:** We may share your information with our affiliates, in which case we will require those affiliates to honor this Privacy Policy. Affiliates include our parent company and any other subsidiaries, joint venture partners, or other companies that we control or that are under common control with us.
- **With business partners:** We may share your information with our business partners to offer you certain products, services, or promotions.

- **With other users:** When you share personal information or otherwise interact in public areas with other users, such information may be viewed by all users and may be publicly distributed outside.
- **With your consent:** We may disclose your personal information for any other purpose with your consent.

3. RETENTION OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Strambly Blamby LLC will retain your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your Personal Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

Strambly Blamby LLC will also retain Usage Data for internal analysis purposes. Usage Data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of stramblyblamby.com, or we are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

4. TRANSFER OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

a. Data Transfer

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at Strambly Blamby LLC's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. This means that your information may be transferred to—and maintained on—computers located outside of your state, province, country, or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ from those in your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer. Strambly Blamby LLC will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of your Personal Data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of your data and other personal information.

b. Transfers to Third Parties

Strambly Blamby LLC takes responsibility for ensuring that any third parties to whom we transfer personal data process such data in a manner consistent with applicable data protection laws and this Privacy Policy. We use contractual and other measures to ensure appropriate safeguards are in place when transferring personal data to third parties acting on our behalf.

5. DELETION OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

You have the right to delete or request that we assist you in deleting the Personal Data that we have collected about you.

Our site, stramblyblamby.com, may give you the ability to delete certain information about yourself from within the Service.

You may update, amend, or delete your information at any time by signing in to your account, if you have one, and visiting the account settings section that allows you to manage your personal information. You may also contact us to request access to, correct, or delete any personal information that you have provided to us.

Please note, however, that we may need to retain certain information when we have a legal obligation or lawful basis to do so.

6. DISCLOSURE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

a. Business Transactions

If Strambly Blamby LLC is involved in a merger, acquisition, or asset sale, your Personal Data may be transferred. We will provide notice before your Personal Data is transferred and becomes subject to a different Privacy Policy.

b. Law Enforcement

Under certain circumstances, Strambly Blamby LLC may be required to disclose your Personal Data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests from public authorities (e.g., a court or a government agency).

c. Other Legal Requirements

Strambly Blamby LLC may disclose your Personal Data in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to:

- Comply with a legal obligation
- Protect and defend the rights or property of Strambly Blamby LLC
- Prevent or investigate possible wrongdoing in connection with the Service
- Protect the personal safety of users of the Service or the public
- Protect against legal liability

7. SECURITY OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Strambly Blamby LLC makes every effort to protect Personal Data and prevent unauthorized access, loss, abuse, alteration, or destruction of information. The security of your Personal Data is important to us but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security, but we continuously enhance our security measures to protect your data.

8. DATA INTEGRITY

We will process Personal Data in a manner that is compatible with and relevant to the purpose for which it was collected, ensuring it remains relevant and compatible with legal and business requirements.

9. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to access, correct, or delete your data. If you have concerns about the handling of your personal data, please contact us to address your queries or complaints. Depending on your jurisdiction, you may have additional rights under applicable data protection laws, including the right to data portability, the right to restrict processing, and the right to object to certain processing activities.

10. CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

stramblyblamby.com does not address anyone under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 13. If you are a parent or guardian and you are aware that your child has provided us with Personal Data, please contact us. If we become aware that we have collected Personal Data from anyone under the age of 13 without verification of parental consent, we will take steps to remove that information from our servers.

If we need to rely on consent as a legal basis for processing your information and your country requires consent from a parent, we may require your parent's consent before we collect and use that information.

11. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Strambly Blamby LLC is committed to resolving complaints and disputes regarding the processing of personal data. We provide the following mechanisms for dispute resolution:

a. Direct Complaints to Strambly Blamby LLC

Individuals may bring a complaint directly to Strambly Blamby LLC. Upon receiving a complaint, we will respond to the individual within 45 days and work to resolve the issue promptly.

b. Independent Resolution

If you are not satisfied with our response to your complaint, you may have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority or seek other remedies available under applicable law.

14. COMPLIANCE
